Who Asked for You?

(A Message to Members of the Body of Christ)

(Preached on Wednesday, August 19, 2020)

"The Pharisees therefore said among themselves, Perceive ye how ye prevail nothing? behold, the world is gone after him. And there were certain Greeks among them that came up to worship at the feast: the same came therefore to Philip, which was of Bethsaida of Galilee, and desired him, saying, Sir, we would see Jesus. Philip cometh and telleth Andrew: and again Andrew and Philip tell Jesus. And Jesus answered them, saying, The hour is come, that the Son of man should be glorified. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit. He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that hateth his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal. If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honour."

Introduction

Today, we will allow this passage, this history, these words recorded in the living Word of God to speak to us. You do believe in God, don't you? You do believe that the Bible is "quick, and powerful, and sharper than *any* twoedged sword" don't you? Then hear him; hear God; hear what he has to say... to you, *today*!!

But first, oh, christian, oh, would be soulwinner, hear his utterly correct description of those for whom Christ died, of those to whom you have been sent to win. Here then is the inmost soul of men, revealed to you through the Word of God in Psalm 107:23-32.

"They that go down to the sea in ships, that do business in great waters; these see the works of the Lord, and his wonders in the deep. For he commandeth, and raiseth the stormy wind, which lifteth up the waves thereof. They mount up to the heaven, they go down again to the depths: their soul is melted because of trouble. They reel to and fro, and stagger like a drunken man, and are at their wit's end. Then they cry unto the Lord in their trouble, and he bringeth them out of their distresses. He maketh the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof are still. Then are they glad because they be quiet; so he bringeth them unto their desired haven. Oh that men would praise the Lord for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men! Let them exalt him also in the congregation of the people, and praise him in the assembly of the elders." (Psalm 107:23-32)

C. They will be able to receive life from him because he did right?
