"...and the Lord my God shall come, and all the saints with thee." (Zechariah 14:5)

- C. His Kingdom comes when we and "all the holy angels" return "with him."
- "When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory:" (Matthew 25:31)
- "And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean." (Revelation 19:14)

II. "Thy will be done!"

"Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven." (Matthew 6:10)

A. His will will be done all over the world.

"They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea." (Isaiah 11:9)

B. His will will be done with no spiritual opposition.

"And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years," (Revelation 20:2)

C. His will will be done with your personal support.

"Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years." (Revelation 20:6)

"When he shall come to be glorified in his saints, and to be admired in all them that believe (because our testimony among you was believed) in that day." (2 Thessalonians 1:10)

C. You are going to enjoy a perfect peace, forever!

"And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, 'Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them,"

(Revelation 21:3a)

IV. "As it is in heaven!"

"Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven." (Matthew 6:10)

"And they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God." (Revelation 21:3b)

A. Heaven on Earth is holiness!

B. Heaven on Earth is happiness!

"And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away." (Revelation 21:4)

C. Heaven on Earth is heavenliness!

"And he that sat upon the throne said, 'Behold, I make all things new.' And he said unto me, 'Write: for these words are true and faithful." (Revelation 21:5)
