I. Jesus "is!"



- "I am ..., saith the Lord, which is," (Revelation 1:8)
 - "And God said unto Moses, 'I Am That I Am': and he said, 'Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I Am hath sent me unto you." (Exodus 3:14)
 - "Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, 1 an." (John 8:58)

II. Jesus "was!"



"I am ..., saith the Lord, which was," (Revelation 1:8)

 "Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world." (John 17:24)

III. Jesus will be!



"I am ..., saith the Lord, which is to come," (Revelation 1:8)

• "For I say unto you, Ye shall not see me henceforth, till ye shall say, Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord." (Matthew 23:39)

IV. Jesus declares that he "is ... the Almighty!"



- "I am ..., saith the Lord, ... the Almighty," (Revelation 1:8)
 - "Alas for the day! for the day of the Lord is at hand, and as a destruction from the Almighty shall it come." (Joel 1:15)
 - "My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand. 1 and my Father are one." (Isaiah 9:6)

A. He is your only almighty constant!

Definition of the word constant: "Occurring continuously over a period of time."

"Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever." (Hebrews 13:8)

B. He is your only almighty salvation!

"The woman saith unto him, 'I know that Messias [Savior] cometh, which is called Christ: when he is come, he will tell us all things.' Jesus saith unto her, 'I that speak unto thee am he." (John 4:25-26)



C. He your only almighty end of fear everlasting - if you believe on him!

"So when they had rowed about five and twenty or thirty furlongs they see Jesus walking on the sea, and drawing nigh unto the ship: and they were afraid. But he saith unto them, 'It is I; be not afraid." (John 6:19-20)

D. He is your only almighty beginning of fear everlasting - if you don't! "I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins." (John 8:24)



E. He is your only almighty one that was lifted up for you! "Then said Jesus unto them, When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that I am he, and that I do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught me, I speak these things." (John 8:28)

F. And he, the Almighty, said that he would give his life for yeal "Now I tell you before it come, that, when it is come to pass, ye may believe that I am he." (John 13:19)



G. ... And he did!

"Jesus therefore, knowing all things that should come upon him, went forth, and said unto them, 'Whom seek ye?"



"They answered him, 'Jesus of Nazareth.' Jesus saith unto them, 'I am he.' And Judas also, which betrayed him, stood with them." (John 18:4-5)
